The system is called Rhonda. The drawing is a bit on the abstract art side, which is a good thing as well, but it is easy to see the level of control he has.

Unfortunately, the bad thing about 3d drawing is that there are a relatively small number of people on the planet that really want to do it. So, it is unlikely these interfaces become widespread outside the domain.
