Oceans is a documentary film by Jacques Perrin, distributed by DisneyNature. According to the official website, the film explores the oceans of the Earth's surface and the mysteries that lie beneath. It is DisneyNature's second release following Earth in 2009.

It counted with a budget of 60 million euros, it was filmed in over 50 different places and took 3 years to film. The movie is a high-quality filming documentary featuring ocean animals. It reflects the need to respect nature and demonstrates the negative impact of human interaction on animals, to the point of favouring the disappearance of species.
